KITTS, 31st August 2020 (Inland Revenue Department) – The St. Kitts and Nevis Inland Revenue Department (SKNIRD) wishes to advise all entities registered as Exempt Companies under the Companies Act Cap. 21.03 of the Revised Laws of SKN 2017, Nevis International Business Corporations (NIBCs) under the Nevis Business Corporation Ordinance and Nevis Limited Liability Corporations (NLLCs) under the Nevis Limited Liability Company Ordinance of the extended submission deadline of the CIT-101 Return.

The SKNIRD would like to thank the registered agents for their continued efforts in ensuring the jurisdiction meets its reporting obligations to the OECD FHTP in filing the required CIT-101 Return. As part of support measures to assist you in collecting the required information from the registered entities, the submission deadline of the CIT-101 Return has been extended until **31st October 2020**. This extension is automatic, so no additional extension requests need to be filed to take advantage of the new deadline. As a result, no late filing penalties will be levied during the extension period.
